Born in Mauritius in 1946, he holds a BA (Hons) in Industrial Economics from Nottingham University in the United Kingdom. He worked in United Kingdom until 1972 when he returned to Mauritius and joined Rogers, a leading Mauritian Commercial and Services Group. He became Chief Executive of Rogers in 1999 and retired in December 2006.

Today, he is non executive Chairman of Rogers and a Director of Air Mauritius (the National Airline). He is also a director of New Mauritius Hotels (the island's leading hotel group). He has executive responsibilities at Scott & Co Ltd, one of Mauritius' oldest commercial concerns which undertakes the import and distribution of foodstuffs and alcoholic and non alcoholic drinks.

He is the Chairman of the National Committee on Corporate Governance and a past Chairman of the Mauritius Chamber of Commerce and Industry. He is the Honorary Consul of Norway in Mauritius.
